

ORDINANCE 208-14

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF WILLIAMS AMENDING SECTION 10.32.295 OF THE WILLIAMS
MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING LARGE VEHICLE PARKING RESTRICTIONS**

The City Council of the City of Williams does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Section 10.32.295 of the City's Municipal Code regarding Large Vehicle Parking Restrictions.

SECTION 2. Authority. The City Council enacts this ordinance under the authority granted to cities by Article XI, Section 7 of the California Constitution.

SECTION 3. Amendment. Section 10.32.295 of the Municipal Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

10.32.295 Large vehicle parking restrictions. No person shall stop or leave standing any vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of eight thousand pounds on Ruggieri Street, or on 6th Street from E Street to F Street.

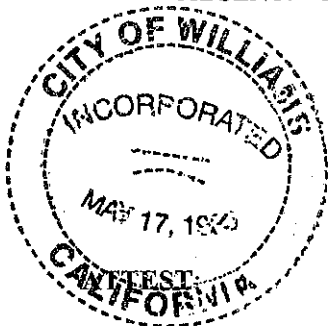
SECTION 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 5. Publication. Within fifteen (15) days of passage of this ordinance, the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it, or a summary of it, to be posted in three public places within the City of Williams.
