SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE 195-12
SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AND RECYCLING

At a meeting of the City Council of the City of Williams, California held on Wednesday, September 19, 2012, Council adopted the following Ordinance.

With the passage of Assembly Bill 341, a statewide 75% solid waste diversion goal was established. The bill outlines a mandatory commercial recycling program, and the formal regulatory processing of the mandatory commercial recycling regulation. Local jurisdictions are required to meet these mandates which have been extended to businesses.

A full copy of the proposed Ordinance is available in the office of the City Clerk between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for review. This Ordinance will become effective within 30 days of such adoption.
