

RESOLUTION NO. 09-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS
ADOPTING PARKING VIOLATION FINES**

WHEREAS, Williams Municipal Code section 10.33.010 and California Vehicle Code section 40203.5 authorize the City to establish a schedule of civil penalties for violations of the City's parking regulations, including the civil penalty itself as well as related late payment penalties, administrative fees, and other related charges, and the criminal justice facilities and court construction assessments due the County of Colusa pursuant to Government Code title 8, chapter 12 (commencing with section 76000); and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to adopt an appropriate penalty schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Williams the schedule of civil penalties (and related fees, costs and assessments) for parking violations in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein is hereby adopted and established, and it shall be the schedule of civil penalties to apply to violations of vehicle parking regulations under the Williams Municipal Code.

Per California Vehicle Code section 40226, in lieu of collecting a fine for a citation for W.M.C. 10.32.110, failure to display a disabled placard, the City may charge an administrative fee of \$25.00 to process cancellation of a citation in any case where the individual who received the citation can show proof that he or she had been issued a valid placard at the time the citation was received.

Late Payment Penalty: Any civil penalty not paid within 21 days of the date of the notice of violation (as fixed on the notice) shall incur an additional late payment penalty of 50% of the basic civil penalty.

Delinquent Penalty: Any civil penalty not paid within 15 days of the date of the notice of delinquent parking violation (as fixed on the notice) shall incur an additional penalty (in addition to the late payment penalty) of 50% of the basic civil penalty.

Costs of Collection: If a civil penalty shall become delinquent and the City pursues collection of the civil penalty, then, in addition to the total civil penalty, late payment penalty, and delinquent penalty, there shall also be added to the amount due the city's actual costs of collection of the delinquent penalty, including but not necessarily limited to debt collection agency fees and costs, attorney's fees, court costs, and City staff time and expenses.
