

RESOLUTION No. 09-26
A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF WILLIAMS ACCEPTING THE REBATE FUNDS, DIRECT THEIR USE
IN THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT, AND ACCEPT THE PG&E
SAVINGS BY DESIGN OWNER AGREEMENT.

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric operates a program to improve the energy efficiency of new industrial equipment systems, and

WHEREAS, This program provides incentives to use energy efficient equipment to reduce energy use, and

WHEREAS, the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) project has been evaluated by Pacific Gas & Electric and has identified significant energy savings, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric has determined to corresponding savings for the WWTP project will yield a incentive payment to the City of \$79,964, and

WHEREAS, Pacific Gas & Electric offered the City the opportunity to participate in this Savings by Design Owner program, and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WILLIAMS, CALIFORNIA RESOLVES THAT: The City Council agrees to participate in the PG&E Saving By Design Owner program, and

FURTHER RESOLVES THAT: The City accepts the PG&E rebate funds in the amount of \$79,964 (seventy-nine thousand nine-hundred sixty-four dollars), and

FURTHER RESOLVES THAT: The City directs this rebate be used in the City's Wastewater Treatment Plant Project, and

FURTHER RESOLVES THAT: The City directs the City Administrator to execute the PG&E Savings By Design Owner Agreement.
