

RESOLUTION NO. 10-22
RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS CORRECTING
APPROPRIATIONS LIMITS FROM FISCAL YEAR 2001-2002 THROUGH FISCAL
YEAR 2009-2010

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California Constitution provided for the establishment of annual appropriations limits on local government entities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 7910, the governing body of each local agency is required each year to establish its appropriations limitation and make other necessary determinations by resolution for the following fiscal year in accordance with the procedures set forth therein and in Article XIII B of the California Constitution; and

WHEREAS, in calculating annual appropriations subject to limitation, Article XIII B Section 1 directs the City to adjust its prior year appropriations limitation for the change in the cost of living and the change in population; and

WHEREAS, Article XIII B Section 8(e)2) defines "change in the cost of living" as either (A) the percentage change in California per capita personal income from the preceding year, or (B) the percentage change in the local assessment roll from the preceding year for the City due to the addition of local nonresidential new construction, and directs the City to select its change in the cost of living annually by a recorded vote of its governing body; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 7901(a) defines "change in population" and provides that the City may choose to use either (A) the change in population within its jurisdiction, or (B) within the county in which it is located, and directs the City to select its change in population annually by a recorded vote of its governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Williams DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council establishes the amount of \$2,007,414 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2001-2002.

SECTION 2. The City Council establishes the amount of \$2,067,636 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2002-2003 selecting the change in additional local nonresidential new construction from the preceding year as the "change in the cost of living" factor.

SECTION 3. The City Council establishes the amount of \$2,212,371 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2003-2004.

SECTION 4. The City Council establishes the amount of \$2,391,573 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2004-2005.

SECTION 5. The City Council establishes the amount of \$2,822,295 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2005-2006.

SECTION 6. The City Council establishes the amount of \$3,104,525 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2006-2007.

SECTION 7. The City Council establishes the amount of \$3,352,887 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2007-2008.

SECTION 8. The City Council establishes the amount of \$3,587,589 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2008-2009.

SECTION 9. The City Council establishes the amount of \$3,641,403 as the City's corrected appropriations limit for fiscal year 2009-2010.

SECTION 10. As provided in Government Code Section 7910, any challenge to the appropriations limit herein established or any other determinations made herein must be brought within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this resolution.
