

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-06**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS  
DETERMINING THE ELECTED CITY CLERK AS AN UNPAID POSITION**

WHEREAS, the City of Williams City Clerk is an elected position that is currently vacant; and

WHEREAS, all of the City Clerk functions are being performed by a contract employee who is a Certified Municipal Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City adopted Resolution 06-05 increasing the elected City Clerk's salary to \$750 per month effective January 2006; and

WHEREAS, because no services currently are needed from an elected City Clerk, the City Council wishes to eliminate the salary for such position.

**THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WILLIAMS,  
CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby repeals Resolution No. 06-05, "A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Williams Approving a Salary Increase for the City Clerk."

Section 2. The City Council hereby determines that the elected City Clerk shall be an unpaid position.

Section 3. If in the future a Certified Municipal Clerk is elected to the City Clerk position, the City Council may determine an appropriate salary for him or her.
