A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE AND EXECUTION OF A TRANSPORTATION PLANNING GRANT FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTION

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WHEREAS, the City of Williams is in the process of updating its General Plan Circulation Element to include multi-modal transportation components and is developing a redevelopment plan for this downtown target area to help revitalize the community; and

WHEREAS, the City is seeking funding to work collaboratively with other agencies to develop a master design plan, "the Project", for Old Highway 99 W to support the revitalization of the Old Highway 99 W corridor through the downtown and improve multi-modal transportation opportunities to improve access into and out of the downtown in Williams; and

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~~WHEREAS~~, the Project is defined as a multi-modal circulation and downtown revitalization plan that will include design components such as wide, separated sidewalks, street trees and other landscaping, street furniture and other amenities as appropriate and will provide design guidance for Old Highway 99 W property frontage, as well as the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Project will help support development and implementation of City goals provided in the General Plan Update and Redevelopment Plan.

THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS, CALIFORNIA, RESOLVES TO:

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1. Authorize the City Administrator to submit a State of California Transportation Planning Grant for the Project.
2. Authorize the City Administrator to take all necessary steps to secure the grant funds from the State of California Department of Transportation to provide funds for the Project.
3. Authorize and empower the City Administrator to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to contracts, subcontracts, applications, agreements, extensions, renewals, payment requests, and amendments of funding provided by the Federal Highway Administration and California Department of Transportation which may be necessary for the completion of the Project.
4. Authorize the City Administrator to accept appropriate, expend, and administer the grant funds, if secured, in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in the approved grant for the Project.
