

RESOLUTION 11-10

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS, CALIFORNIA,
RESTRICTING PARKING EXCEPT BY PERMIT ON SEGMENTS OF SEVENTH STREET**

WHEREAS, Section 22507 of the California Vehicle Code authorizes local agencies to restrict or prohibit the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles on local streets during all or certain hours of the day; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that portions of Seventh Street have been and continue to be adversely impacted by parking of trucks and other vehicles by individuals who are not patrons of businesses on Seventh Street; and

WHEREAS, the owners of businesses on Seventh Street from B Street to D Street, have expressed interest in having preferential parking privileges on Seventh Street; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that a permit parking program will alleviate the parking issues on Seventh Street for the owners and patrons of businesses of Seventh Street from B Street to D Street; and

WHEREAS, the cost of implementing a permit parking program is nominal and the situation is created by circumstances beyond the control of the affected businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Williams does hereby resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. A permit parking program shall be established on the following segments of City streets:

- Seventh Street, from B Street to D Street.
- B Street, from Seventh Street to Sixth Street.

SECTION 2. Under the permit parking program, no person shall stop, park, or leave standing any vehicle on Seventh Street, from B Street to D Street, and on B Street, from Seventh Street to Sixth Street, without the required parking permit.

SECTION 3. The Director of Public Works is hereby directed to place appropriate signs giving adequate notice of these prohibitions.
