

RESOLUTION 16-13

DECERTIFICATION OF WILLIAMS MISCELLANEOUS EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION AND RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC EMPLOYEES UNION, LOCAL #1 AS THE EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE.

WHEREAS, On March 1, 2016 City Administrator Kennedy was notified by Public Employees Union, Local #1 (Local #1) that a petition has been signed by 100% of the group to decertify the Williams Miscellaneous Employees Association and to authorize Local #1 to represent the group;

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Article II, Section 7 (d.) of the City of Williams Employer-Employee Relations Rules and Regulation (Resolution #90-4), Local #1 has filed a decertification petition in the form of a recognition petition. All fifteen (15) employees currently within that bargaining unit voted to have Local #1 be their representative;

WHEREAS, On July 13, 2016 a formal election has held in which all members voted YES to, "Do you wish to have Public Employees' Union, Local #1 as your Exclusive Representative for all purposes of meeting and conferring/negotiating with the employer (City of Williams) on wages, hours and other terms and conditions of employment under MMBA section 3500 et seq.?"

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLIAMS AS FOLLOWS:

The employee bargaining unit previously known as the Williams Miscellaneous Employees Association is decertified and the Public Employees Union, Local #1 is now the exclusive representative of the Miscellaneous Unit.

I HEREBY CERTIFY that the foregoing Resolution was duly introduced, passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Williams, held on the 18th of May 2016, by the following vote:


