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BASIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PERMIT. This permit is issued pursuant to chapter 12.14 of the Williams Municipal Code, which chapter is incorporated herein by this reference.

NOTICE TO CITY. **Before starting work, the permittee shall notify the Department of Public Works, (530) 473-2519, one working day in advance of the date work is to begin.**

WORK AND MATERIALS. All work and materials shall be in accordance with the current edition of the City of Williams Department of Public Works Standard Plans.

KEEP PERMIT ON WORK SITE. This permit shall be kept at the site of the work and must be shown to any representative of the City upon demand.

RETURN OF DEPOSIT. The security deposit, less costs of inspection by City, shall be released to permittee 180 days after satisfactory completion of the work, so long as permittee is then in full compliance with the terms of this permit.

GUARANTEE. Should any failure of the work occur within a period of one year after approval by the City which can be attributed to faulty materials, poor workmanship or defective equipment provided by the permittee, then the permittee shall promptly make the needed repairs at its sole expense.

U.S.A. NOTIFICATION. The permittee shall notify, and obtain an inquiry identification number from, Underground Service Alert-Northern California at least two working days in advance of performing excavation work by calling the toll-free number (800) 642-2444.

U.S.A. notification shall be renewed at not more than 14 calendar day intervals. This permit shall not be valid unless the permittee has been provided an initial inquiry identification number by U.S.A. The permittee shall comply with the statutes, rules and regulations of U.S.A. and the California Regional Notification Center System.

PROSECUTION OF WORK. Any work authorized by this permit shall be performed in a workmanlike, diligent and expeditious manner to the satisfaction of the Public Works Director.

ROAD CLOSURE. No street or alley may be closed without first obtaining approval in writing from the Public Works Director.

MAINTAINING AND PROTECTING TRAFFIC CONTROL FACILITIES. Metal objects (such as manhole frames and lids, valve boxes, bore casings, etc.) shall not be installed within 72 inches of a traffic detector loop. Any traffic signal or detector operation disruption shall be repaired and the system made operational within eight hours of the damage. Should the City elect to provide repair or replacement services, the permittee shall be required to reimburse the City for all costs involved.

TUNNELING. No tunneling shall be permitted except on major work as may be specifically set forth on this permit.

TRENCHING. Not more than one-half of the width of a traveled way shall be disturbed at one time and the remaining width shall be kept open to traffic by bridging or backfilling.

UNDERGROUND UTILITIES. Damage to or destruction of underground utilities shall be immediately reported to the owner of the subject utility and the Public Works Director, and permittee shall be responsible for all costs of repair and/or replacement.

DITCHES. All roadside drainage ditches shall be restored to a true grade and intake and outlet ends of all culverts shall be left free from all excess materials and debris.

RECORD DRAWINGS. Upon completion of work, the permittee, at the request of the Public Works Director, shall furnish record drawings (aka as-built drawings) to the City showing location and details of work performed.

FUTURE RELOCATION OF IMPROVEMENTS. Upon demand by the City whenever construction, reconstruction, maintenance or traffic conditions on the street or right-of-way may require it, the permittee at its sole expense shall relocate the improvements installed under this permit. The permittee shall commence the relocation within the time specified in the City's demand and thereafter diligently prosecute the same to completion.

MAINTENANCE. The permittee shall (1) exercise reasonable care to maintain properly any improvements installed under this permit, and (2) immediately repair any damage to the street or right-of-way which occurs as a result of the presence or maintenance of the encroachment or as a result of the work done under this permit, including any and all damage to the roadway which would not have occurred had such work not been done or such encroachment not installed.

INDEMNIFICATION. The permittee shall be responsible for all claims, damages, costs and liabilities arising out of work performed under this permit. The permittee shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the City, its officers, employees, volunteers and agents from and against all claims, damages, costs and liabilities of every nature arising out of work performed under this permit.
